Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding executed in Dehradun, Uttarakhand on **May 02**, day of **2023** between **Aasraa Trust** represented by **Ms. Shaila Brijnath** (Chairman) having their registered office at 119/1, Vasant Vihar, Dehradun (hereinafter referred to as Aasraa Trust or the First Party).

AND

DIT University represented by **Dr. Surbhi Sachdev**, Officiating Registrar having their registered office at DIT University, Mussoorie - Diversion Road, Village Makkawala, Dehradun, Uttarakhand-248009 (hereinafter referred to as **DIT University** or the Second Party).

WHEREAS

- (a) **Aasraa** is a registered trust under the Indian Trust Act as a public charitable trust, committed to the cause of empowering children. Focused on education, it has been working with street and slum children in Dehradun since 2009, with the belief that there is no unreachable or unteachable child. Aasraa has a vision of life with dignity for all underprivileged children. The cycle of poverty which rules their existence needs to be broken. Aasraa believes that the outside intervention needed to break this cycle is education and vocational training combined with health care, nutrition, clothing & shelter homes.
- (b) **DIT University** as an Institution "Dehradun Institute of Technology" was established in 1998, achieved the status of University by Govt. of Uttarakhand vide Act No.10 of 2013 dated 15 February 2013 and is recognized by UGC under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956. DIT University with the aphorism of Imagine, Aspire and Achieve fosters the long-term commitment towards nation building. Since its establishment in 1998, it has maintained the best practices in Higher Education.

1. PREAMBLE

Subscribing to many of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (No Poverty, Zero Hunger, Good Health and Wellbeing and Quality Education), the Aasraa Trust has been working towards empowering children from the streets and slums of Dehradun through education, vocational training, nutrition, health care and shelter. The vision of Aasraa is that there is no unreachable or unteachable child.

With the formation of Uttarakhand state, the capital city of Dehradun has seen large scale migration of people from the neighboring states. In addition, the rate of migration from the hilly areas of the state has also rapidly increased due to the decline in agricultural growth.

Education on its own is not enough. Children must be given a dream and the means to achieve it. The need for providing vocational training and quality higher education is so important.

2. COMMON GOAL AND PURPOSE

Both parties to this MoU share the broad goal of creating a well-educated and skilled workforce from among the marginalized sections of society. The purpose of this MoU is to provide an opportunity to the underserved children to attain quality Education at DIT University. DIT University has agreed to provide 50% waiver (On Tuition Fee & Academic Services Fee only) for 02 students every year. This opportunity will be provided to the 02 deserving students who have graduated (top 5%) from Aasraa's projects.

Both the parties agree to work in collaboration and have arrived at an understanding as indicated below:

3. Role and Responsibilities:

(a) Aasraa Trust:

- To shortlist 02 deserving candidates for the scholarship offered by DIT University every year.
- To ensure that candidates have the aptitude required for the course/degree.
- To ensure that the student has all the required documents available for the admission.
- To ensure that student has the resources to pay for the rest of the fee amount.
- To appoint a point of contact to coordinate with the DIT University.
- To ensure that the candidates are meeting applicable eligibility criterion of the respective program
- To ensure that the candidates fall under the top 5% child of Aasraa Trust

(b) DIT University:

- To provide 50% fee waiver (On Tuition Fee & Academic Services Fee only) for 02 new students every year.
- To provide Aasraa Trust with the detailed breakup of the fee structure for the course/ degree, for which the students have applied.
- To appoint a point of contact to coordinate with the Aasraa Trust.
- The final decision on the offer of admission to the candidates recommended by Aasraa trust will be with DIT University. Further the program to which the candidate will be admitted will be decided by DIT University.

4. Period of Partnership:

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of 02 Years from the date of its signature and seal and extendable for a further period of one or more years' subject to the concurrence of both the parties. The parties to this memorandum may, by mutual consent, add modify,

amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition(s) of this agreement. The MoU may be terminated by either side by giving a six-month notice to that effect in writing. However, notwithstanding the notice of the intent to terminate the memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated until the finalization and accomplishment thereof.

1. Non - Exclusively:

Nothing in this MoU shall mean or shall be constructed to mean that any of the party is at any time precluded from having similar arrangements with any other person or third party.

2. Arbitration and Jurisdiction:


In case of any disputes arising between the parties in respect of implementation of the program or the payments agreed to be made by the first party or in respect of any other term in this MoU, the parties undertake to settle the same by mutual negotiation and in case no such settlement is arrived at after mutual negotiations, an arbitrator shall be appointed for resolving any or all the disputes that may arise between the parties as per the law applicable in jurisdiction of courts in Dehradun.

Aasraa Trust and the DIT University agree to share responsibility for the successful implementation of the project prescribed in this MoU.
