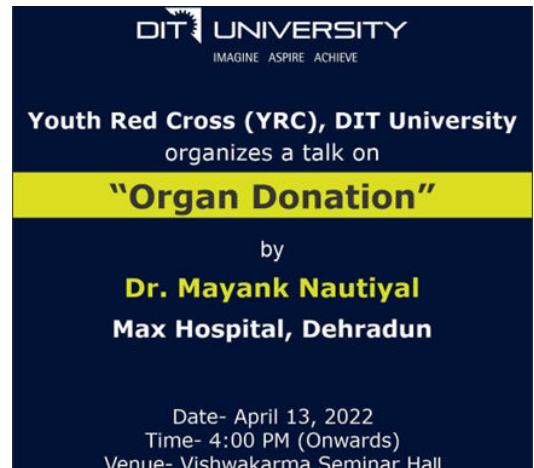

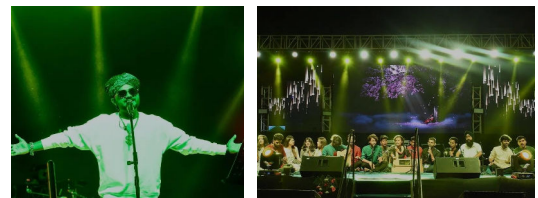
Workshop on “Intellectual Property Rights”

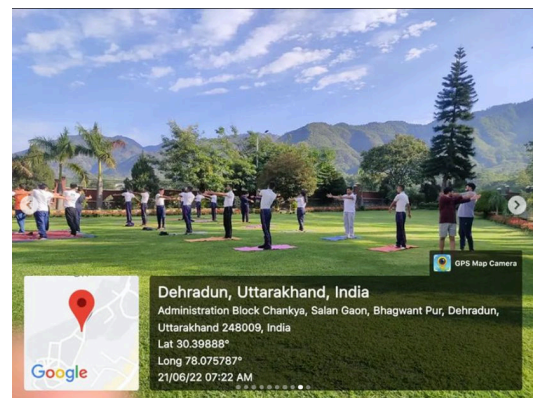
A total of 9 participants and 11 faculties participated making the event a huge success.

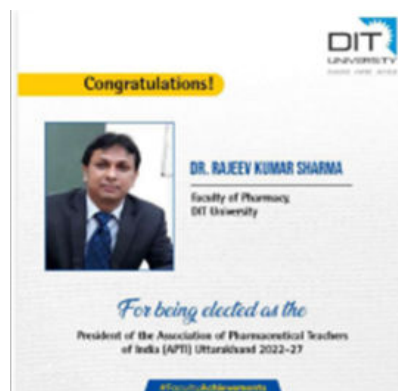
