

1. Sir, you took the charge of Director in the mid of pandemic. What opportunities and challenges you find in it?

A tough situation not only brings with it challenges, but multiple opportunities too. The year and half gone by has really been exacting for all of us, and the pandemic did show us that nature always has the last say. The students have been the most dis-advantaged during this period. They have missed the 'classroom' experience and have been confined to study from home, sitting tirelessly for hours in front of screens. The biggest challenge, if I have to put that first, is to bring the students back to the classroom, not only physically but mentally too. The pandemic is still hovering around, although the vaccination drive has helped allay some of the fears. The parents are still scared to send their wards, and we are aware. Being physically present in the University is one of the most important aspects in a student's life especially in the field of technology. We as university are creating the enabling environment, by ensuring necessary safety protocols, running vaccination drives and following social distancing norms, while classes begin in the right earnest.

As Director of STEAM, I feel there is immense scope and opportunity to amalgamate the course curriculum to include and assimilate each of these five arms of Science, Engineering, Technology, Arts and Management to provide a wholesome academic experience to students across all programs. DIT University is already on the right path and I am sure the already implemented Fully Flexible Choice Based Credit System is a step in the right direction.

1. Sir, how would you think the online education will be able to compensate the field work?

The pandemic year has taught us many a thing, especially in the field of education. All university's went into an online teaching mode to ensure that the students' academic progression didn't suffer. The teaching fraternity adapted well to the online medium for delivering academic content. The MS Teams, Zoom, Google classroom etc. became household names in a matter of days. This medium of online education has already been in use, but only in bits and pieces. So, I would say, this really helped students to carry on with their learning despite not being physically present in the university. But, I don't think this mode could really be able to fully compensate for the laboratory and field work. Virtual labs, though available, do provide an

alternative, but are not adequate for a student to get that real experience and knowledge that fieldwork can provide. Online education has allowed us to bring new and innovative ideas that have contributed to students' education and learning but there is a still a long way to go before it can catch up with the off-line in campus experience.

3. Sir, what are your priorities during your first year as Director, STEAM?

It has been two months since I joined this wonderful university and I have already starting feeling to be an integral part of DIT University. My first priority is to make sure that the students get the full experience of offline classes which they have missed during the lockdown, while following all necessary protocols and safety measures.

We have recently implemented a fully flexible choice-based credit system (FFCBCS) for the students which is very much in sync with the new National Education Policy. This provides equal opportunities to all students to study at their own pace and build their own degree. I would like all the students to be enlightened about its benefits and take full advantage of this flexibility. The academic faculty mentors need to be on board to share insights with their student mentees on the advantages of FFCBCS.

We already have some of the best faculty members in our fold, but getting more good faculty on board is the next on my priority list. At DIT University we want to ensure that we get the best brains to teach our students and provide them with the best classroom experience.

To integrate all the five streams, Science, Technology, Management, Arts and Engineering, and to evolve and design innovative programs, which would touch all the five aspects, so that the students get a holistic education experience to be successful and versatile, would be another of the priorities.

4. Sir, why is it exciting to be a part of the DIT University?

It is absolutely exciting to be a part of DIT University, primarily due to the pool of young and exceptional talent it possesses both at the faculty as well as at the student level. It has the right potential and ingredients to be in the top bracket. It is exciting to be in the company of young and bright students, who come dreamy eyed looking for opportunities to grow their expanse of learning. We would always strive to provide to them the best of opportunities to learn and also let them experience the world that they are going to, not only be a part of, but build too. Nothing excites me more than being in the company of students and share my experience with them and in turn learn from them too.

5. Sir, what message would you like to give to the students of the Editorial Board?

You have a great opportunity to paint the image of DIT University through your writings, so present a true picture of your university in the right way so that it not only excites the outer world but also the inside community of DIT University. So my message to you all would be 'Keep doing the good work because a university is not only known by what it does but also by how well it does'. God bless you all.






Webinar on: "Career Prospects in Robotics and Automation"

students and faculty members.



Faculty Development Program on Advance Cyber Security & Forensics in collaboration with E&ICT Academy IIT Kanpur





The event was conducted on campus from 4:00 pm(IST), and the venue was filled by almost 125 participants.



The session started at 5.00 pm and was a huge success as it attracted around 125 students to be a part of it.


