INTRODUCTION

Libraries are constantly facing challenges due to lack of sufficient funds to meet the ever increasing expectations of users due to emerging technologies. Therefore, libraries are bound to innovate the new services and systems to fulfill these expectations from Free/Open Source Software (FOSS) for automation and modernization of services to exploit the ever increasing contents in public domain.

The main agenda of the workshop is to create awareness and familiarity among librarians and other information professionals to adopt and implement the FOSS for their different in-house activities. Two software packages which are planned to be covered are Koha and Dspace.

THE WORKSHOP

The purpose of this workshop is to provide training with adequate practical knowledge to library professionals which will enable them to initiate for modernization of the libraries like Library Automation and Networking and Design and Development of Library Website etc. by using Free/Open Source Software. The workshop will focus on use and application of Koha and DSpace.

DSpace is the software of choice for building digital repositories for academic, non-profit, and commercial organizations. It is open source software and completely customizable to fit the needs of any institute/organization. DSpace preserves and enables easy and open access to all types of digital content including text, images, moving images, mpegs and data sets.

PEDAGOGY

The workshop will be conducted at the DIT University Dehradun. Each participant will be provided a PC supplemented with LCD projected live demos. The pedagogy will be a mix of lectures, discussions, and hands-on sessions. Each participant shall be provided with a CD-ROM comprising of the Koha Automation Software, with Linux and Window version, DSpace, faculty presentations, and other related software packages. Extensive hands-on labs will be a hall mark of this programme.

- ✓To acquaint the participants with the installation of KOHA ✓To provide hands on training to the participants so as to enable them to work independently

- ✓Ability to cope up with any number of Branches, Patrons, Patron Categories, Item Categories, Currencies and other data ✓Describe Joomla's key CMS features ✓Administer website content using Joomla's back end functions
- ✓Install a Joomla instance from scratch

WHO CAN ATTEND?

The workshop is intended for library and information professionals, Librarian, knowledge managers and students who have an interest or are involved in development and implementation of library automation in their respective organizations, particularly professionals from libraries with limited infrastructure and budget. The number of participants is restricted to 30 and admission will be strictly on a first-come-first-served basis.

- ✓User interfaces of Koha-Web-OPAC, Reservation, Statistics, etc.
- ✓System Administration of Koha ✓Describe joomla's key CMS features ✓Administer website content using joomla's back-end functions.


