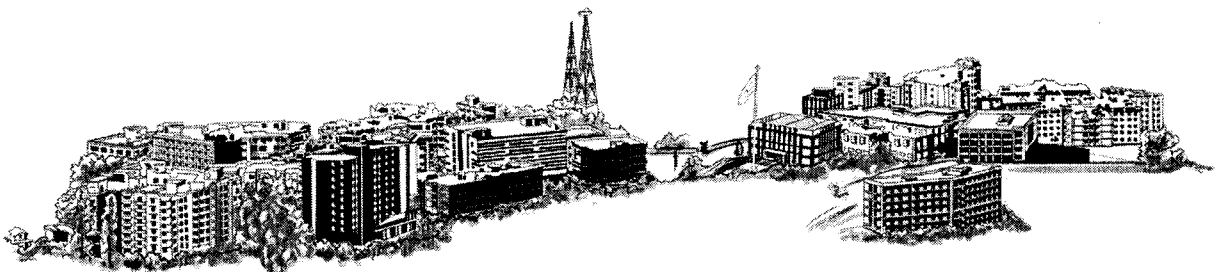

	<i>Board also recommended that for B.Tech, BCA and MCA, Technical Training 2 to be offered in Summer Term immediately after Technical Training 1 (scheduled to be conducted in EVEN semester) – for continuity and better academic preparation of the students.</i>
